The welcoming entrance hall is a showstopper in itself - generously proportioned, with high ceilings and beautifully preserved original features that set the tone for the rest of the home...

The main living room is both striking and inviting, with a grand inglenook fireplace as the centrepiece. To the rear, the room extends further into a tranquil space, perfect for reading, studying or playing music. Discreetly concealed within this room is a secret door leading to a private study, ideal for a home office, complete with French doors opening onto the landscaped gardens.

A second reception room flows effortlessly from the hallway, full of rich character, with another charming period fireplace that adds to the home's warm and storied ambiance.

The heart of the home lies in its kitchen - crafted with bespoke cabinetry, granite worktops, and a central island designed for both style and functionality. It steps down into a spacious family area, ideal for everyday living and entertaining. A well-equipped utility room offers further convenience, with doors leading directly out to the garden.

Practical features abound on the ground floor, including extensive storage for coats and shoes, everything a modern family needs to be effortlessly stored and organised.

Upstairs, a sweeping oak staircase leads to a broad, light-filled landing. The principal suite is a true retreat - beginning with a dressing area and opening into a vaulted-ceiling bedroom with expansive windows that frame breathtaking views of the sea and gardens. The en-suite bathroom is finished to a high standard, offering true indulgence.

Three further double bedrooms are beautifully presented and served by a great size family bathroom. At the far end of the corridor lies a private guest wing, complete with its own bedroom, en-suite shower, and generous storage – perfect for guests, older children, or even a live in nanny.

Outside, the grounds are nothing short of immaculate. Manicured lawns, mature planting, and a swimming pool with pool house and gym facilities create the ultimate garden sanctuary. For those seeking further flexibility, this space could be transformed into a self-contained annexe (STPP). There is also a detached double garage, with magnificent driveway to host multiple cars.




